A Pickering Middle School Building Committee Meeting was held to review the status of the project. A quorum of the School Building Committee was present. J. Cerulli, SBC Chair, called the meeting to order at 2:38 PM.

### I. Approval of Meeting Minutes

### II. Update on Preliminary Design Program (PDP) Progress

Educational Program Sub-Committee Update

4. The first be bi-weekly conference call with MSBA was held on May 6, 2016 to review the site selection process and to discuss the decision-making process. The next conference call is scheduled for May 20, 2016. There is a conference line number should any SBC member which to be part of the conference calls.

#### **Educational Plan**

- The Superintendent, Principal and Department Heads have been working on the Educational Program. A draft will be provided next week.
- 6. Several meetings have been held to inform the Educational Program and include discussions on demographics and location of students, security, environmental and traffic.
- 7. Based on all discussions and research to date, it is felt at this time that a two-school solution would best meet the needs of the District and City. This will be discussed with MSBA.

### Information Needed

- 8. C. Latham requested a list of all the voting School Building Committee members.
- 9. The District will need to address each item in Module 3- Feasibility Study, Appendix 3A in the Educational Program narrative.
- 10. A formal vote on the Preliminary Design Program to approve and submit to the MSBA will be required in advance of the June 10, 2016 submission date. The PDP will be uploaded to the SBC website once complete for review by SBC members.

Site Selection Sub-Committee Update

11. An update on the 9 original sites was provided by RDA. Three additional sites were presented, Gallagher Park, McManus Field and Rockdale Ave. at Mayfair St.

### Site Selection Analysis Matrix

- 12. The criteria for evaluation of all sites was discussed. RDA has begun the Site Selection Analysis Matrix that will evaluate all sites. However, RDA needs to begin to narrow down the site choices that are most viable for in-depth analysis.
- 13. Some of the more critical factors in analyzing the sites were the geo-environmental factors, flood and tidal plain impacts, soil conditions, traffic impacts, travel distances, size of sites and the City-owned property

versus the need for eminent domain.

- 14. It was noted that the extend of ledge and wetlands on the Parkland Avenue reservoir site should be fully delineated on the plans and that an access drive off Avril Street should be explored to avoid the traffic at Wynoma Square.
- 15. The SBC after much discussion decided to focus on McManus Field as the only truly viable site in the West Lynn District and to focus on three sites in the Pickering District: Magnolia Park adjacent to the existing Pickering School; the Parkland Ave. reservoir site; and the Gallagher Park site.
- 16. The following motion and vote were made:

**MOTION:** C. Latham moved, seconded by M. Donovan, that the School Building Committee focus analysis on the McManus Park, Magnolia Park adjacent to the existing Pickering School, the Parkland Avenue reservoir site and the Gallagher Park site.
